





The GBAR fee policy is one of reasonable affordability for test and calibration laboratories. To this end it is GBAR strategy to retrieve the costs of its accreditation activities from a levy based upon the turnover (or number of tests conducted) per year of the test and calibration laboratory.

Therefore, fees are based upon two areas of activity:

- (i) Initial Accreditation Fee based upon administering an application.
- (ii) Ongoing accreditation. Fee based upon activity related to gross turnover.

Please note: there are many variables when calculating the cost of assessing laboratories. The below is presented as a general guide. Please contact us so we can obtain further information and prepare a accurate quotation.

Commercial laboratories:

For first US \$100,000 of company turnover \$1,300.00
For further turnover in excess of US \$500,000 0.1%

Non-commercial/government laboratories:

For first 50,000 test per year \$1,300.00

NOTES

- 1 Unless otherwise specified, the accreditation officer is to be accompanied at all times by the applicant test and calibration laboratory.
- The initial application fee includes the cost of accrediting the first five (5) standards/activities for which accreditation is required.
- 3 Ongoing accreditation shall be a minimum of \$1,100.00).
- Ongoing accreditation fee is due in respect of the gross turnover (or number of tests conducted) of the test and calibration laboratory regardless of the defined scope within Appendix 1 of the Contract/MOU
